

2010 Tuesday Night Mixed League - Rules

- 1) All must be registered with USGA-GHIN handicap system. They must have established, or establishing GHIN handicaps prior to league play. If none, they shall play with zero (0) handicap until one is established. No events will be recalculated. A maximum course handicap of 20 strokes for ladies and 18 strokes for men will be allowed. The league will play with members receiving 100% of the 9-hole course handicap.
- 2) Non-refundable dues will be \$35 per member (\$20 for league prizes, \$5 for party, \$10 for the league scorer) and must be paid by the second night of league.
- 3) Three (3) points awarded for each league match.
 - a. Match play: Two-person best ball match play; winner receives one (1) point.
 - b. Medal play: The "A" (lower handicap) player of one team vs the "A" player of the other team; low net receives one (1) point.
 - c. Medal play: The "B" (higher handicap) player of one team vs the "B" player of the other team; low net receives one (1) point.
 - d. Strokes are given according to handicap holes for match play. The lowest handicap for the foursome will be subtracted from each of the other players with the difference in the strokes applied to the holes.
 - e. Ties after 9-holes shall split the point. (1/2 point to each team).
- 4) All scores must be adjusted and posted in the GHIN computer prior to submitting the card to the league scorer. No scores will be accepted for league standings until they are posted into the GHIN computer. If a player is found to not be posting, they will be notified by the league scorer. If the situation is not remedied, the players name will be given to the FGA Handicap Committee.
- 5) USGA and local rules apply. This includes playing the ball "down". **RULES FOR THIS LEAGUE ONLY** a provisional ball **may** be played if you think a ball is in a hazard. This is to speed up the pace of play.
- 6) If temporary greens are used. You must play to within the putter leather, then pick up, take one more stroke. On regular greens, all holes must be putted out. There are no "gimmies".
- 7) Only the greens keeper closing the course determines rainouts. This includes any reason for course closure. If the course is open for play, we play. If the course is closed that event is cancelled from the schedule. No points awarded.
- 8) Two substitutes may be used for one team. Substitutes MAY NOT be regular members of this league. If a regular member does not play, and a substitute is not used, that player's individual point is forfeited. The other member, or their substitute, may play for their individual point and the team point.
- 9) Matches may be played prior to the scheduled date, or prior to the next scheduled league event, if both teams agree. If another time cannot be pre-arranged, the team UNABLE to make the schedule league time will either get substitutes or forfeit the match.
- 10) If a team does not show for the match within 10 minutes of tee time, and no substitutes have been arranged, the absent team shall forfeit the match. The team receiving the forfeit must play at least 5 holes that evening.
- 11) A team is considered a dropout if they voluntarily resign the league or have made no contact with league members within two weeks of the last time they played. If a replacement team can not be found, all matches played or scheduled for that team shall be null and void. Any replacements shall assume all points as they stand at the time of replacement. Any dropouts would be subject to review for participation in subsequent seasons.
- 12) Awards will be presented to the top 4 teams at the end of the season party to be held at an event on Tuesday, August 12th. Gift certificates shall be given as awards.
